5. Consider appointments to the Tourist Development Council. There are currently two vacancies on the Tourist Development Council (TDC) due to the expired terms of Nancy Sikes-Kline and Michael Gordon. Per F.S. 125.0104, the first vacancy is required to be filled by an elected official from the most populous municipality in the county (City of St. Augustine) and the second vacancy is required to be filled by an owner or operator of a tourist accommodation within the County subject to the bed tax. Both vacancies were advertised in October 2021, for a four week span. Please find attached for review and consideration eight applications, a letter from the City of St Augustine regarding their representative, and a recommendation letter from the Tourist Development Council. Please note Mrs. Sikes-Kline meets the requirement of an elected official from the most populous municipality in the County; however, if appointed, her four-year term would be contingent on her continued role as an elected official of the City of St. Augustine, and Mr. Gordon is the only applicant meeting the requirement of an owner or operator of a tourist accommodation subject to the bed tax.


