1. **Public Hearing** * **PUD 2022-08 Ferber SR 16.** Request to rezone approximately 33 acres from Commercial Intensive (CI) and Planned Unit Development (PUD) to PUD to allow 95,000 square feet of commercial, retail and office uses and 405 multi-family dwelling units. The Planning and Zoning Agency recommended denial of PUD 2022-08, at its August 18, 2022 regular meeting, with a 2-2 vote. The Agency discussed, density, the 60 foot height, parking, traffic on SR 16 and Four Mile Road, and the proposed project's impact on the natural environment. Section 8.01.03.B of the Land Development Code provides: Each decision of the PZA must be approved by a majority vote of the members present at a meeting in which a quorum is in attendance and voting. Failure to receive a majority vote of members present shall act as a denial of the application, appeal, or other matter that is before the PZA. Therefore, the 2-2 tie vote resulted in a denial.

2. Public Hearing * COMPAMD 2021-12 Laurel Point - Transmittal. Request for a Large Scale Comprehensive Plan Amendment to change the Future Land Use Map designation of approximately 80.4 acres of land from Rural/Silviculture/St. Johns River Water Management District (R/S/SJRWMD) to Residential-C (Res-C), with a companion text amendment policy limiting development to a maximum of 175 single-family residential units and a maximum 23,000 square feet of commercial and office space. The Planning and Zoning Agency voted 3 - 1 to recommend transmittal.

Transmittal hearing for a Comprehensive Plan amendment to amend Policy A.1.11.3 to increase the Floor Area Ratio (FAR) from 70% to 120% for the construction of a personal property self-storage facility, within the Mixed Use Future Land Use designation and specifically located at 1855 SR 207. The Planning and Zoning Agency recommended approval of the transmittal of COMPAMD 2022-03, at its August 18, 2022 regular meeting, with a 3-1 vote. The Agency discussed the height of the proposed mini-warehouse structure and precedent being established by allowing a greater FAR than the Comprehensive Plan prescribes. 10. St. Johns County, Florida Water and Sewer Revenue Bonds, Series 2022. On May 17, 2022, the St. Johns County Commission directed staff to assemble a finance team to facilitate required utility bonds to fund their capital improvement plan including a new 3.25 MGD Wastewater Treatment Plan within the State Road 207 Corridor. The October 4, 2022 agenda item provides consideration of a resolution of the Board of County Commissioners, authorizing the issuance of St. Johns County, Florida Water and Sewer Revenue Bonds, Series 2022, in an amount not to exceed \$130,000,000 in order to finance costs of various capital improvements to the Utility System included in the current five-year Capital Improvement Plan. In sum, the resolution authorizes the issuance of the 2022 Bonds, and pledges to budget and appropriate water and sewer revenues to secure payment of the debt service. The Resolution provides for a competitive sale of the Bonds and approves the forms of various financing documents including the Preliminary Official Statement, the Official Notice of Sale, the Continuing Disclosure Certificate and the Paying Agent and Registrar Agreement. The Series 2022 Project includes various water and sewer capital improvements contained within the Issuer's current five-year capital improvement program, including but not limited to a new 3.25 MGD Wastewater Treatment Plant, Master Pump Stations, Reclaim Storage and re-pump facilities and related collection and distribution piping systems for servicing the State Road 207 Corridor as more particularly described in the plans and specifications on file with the Issuer. Here, the Finance Team seeks the Board's approval of this resolution, which includes the required supplemental documents (attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibits A-E), to move forward in issuing the 2022 Bonds. For the Board's convenience in reviewing, each of the exhibits are titled/described below: Exhibit A: General Description of the Series 2022 Project; Exhibit B: Form of Official Notice of Sales; Exhibit C: Form of Preliminary Official Statement; Exhibit D: Form of Continuing Disclosure Certificate; Exhibit E: Form Registrar and Paying Agent Agreement.

11. Palm Valley West Boat Ramp Improvements. The scope of work for this project shall include providing all labor, materials, equipment, and any other items necessary to construct a new concrete boat ramp, construct a new fixed wooden dock with a new floating dock and gangway, construct a new sidewalk, replace/relocate the existing kayak launch, and construct improvements to the parking lot and maneuvering area. The project site is at the existing kayak launch located on the west side of the Intracoastal Waterway, under and just north of the Palm Valley Bridge. SJC Purchasing issued a formal Invitation for Bids in accordance with County Policy and two (2) bids were received, with the lowest, responsive and responsible bid submitted from Hayward Construction Group, LLC, at a total bid price of \$983,742.00. Staff recommends Board approval to award Bid No. 22-100 to Hayward Construction Group, LLC, and to execute a construction contract for completion of the work in accordance with the Bid Documents at the above price. Senior staff will provide a presentation detailing this project and its impact on St. Johns County.

12. Village of West Augustine Discussion. Ability Housing was awarded financing for the development of Village of West Augustine, an affordable housing project in West Augustine. The project includes a 92-unit apartment complex: 10 apartments will be affordable to households earning 33% of the Area Median Income (AMI), 7 apartments will be affordable to households earning 50% AMI, and 73 apartments will be affordable to households earning 60% AMI. Due to an increase in construction costs and interest rates, the funding secured is insufficient to cover development costs. Health and Human Services Staff received a formal request seeking financial relief from the President and CEO of Ability Housing on September 14, 2022.
