The request is to modify the RiverTown Development of Regional Impact (DRI) to revise the school mitigation requirements, address the abandonment of the Eagle nest, which include changes to Map H (DRI Master Plan), the proposed Greenway Map and the Wildlife/Plant Resources Map, add a date certain for the provision of a library site and a fire station site, clarify the residential development rights include age restricted units, and reduce the proposed roundabout locations on SR 13. 
