1. Universal Network Realty LLC Economic Development Grant Agreement. On April 21, 2015 the Board approved request to draft a grant agreement with Universal Network Realty LLC. The first annual grant payment would be anticipated during FY 18, with an estimated annual payout of \$45,122. The total estimated value of the incentive is \$379,611.

2. Consider reappointment of a St. Johns County representative to the Northeast Florida Community Action Agency. This is a request to consider the reappointment of Mr. Benjamin Coney, SJC Housing/Community Development Manager, as the St. Johns County representative on the Board of Directors of the Northeast Florida Community Action Agency (NFCAA). Mr. Coney has been serving in this capacity since the Board of County Commissioners' original appointment to the NFCAA on February 3, 2004. 3. Public Hearing * MAJMOD 2015-02 Arbor Mill II. This is a public hearing for MAJMOD 2015-02, known as Arbor Mill II, a request to add 65 single family residential units to the existing approved PUD, including an additional 36 acres of land. Staff recommends approval of the request based on the proposal's consistency with the Future Land Use designation of Residential-B and compatibility with surrounding properties. 4. Public Hearing * **CPA (SS) 2014-03 Peppertree**. This is an adoption hearing for a Small Scale Comprehensive Plan Amendment, known as Peppertree. The amendment proposes to change the future land use from Residential-B to Residential-C for approximately eight (8) acres to allow a twenty-eight (28) lot, single-family residential subdivision. The property is located on the west side of State Road A1A South, south of Tropic Way and north of San Julian Boulevard on Anastasia Island. The Planning and Zoning Agency recommended adoption of CPA (SS) 2014-03 by a unanimous vote of 5-0 at the March 19, 2015 meeting.

5. Public Hearing * PUD 2014-18 Peppertree. This is a request to rezone 8.01 acres from Commercial Highway Tourist to Planned Unit Development to allow a maximum of twenty-eight (28) single-family residential dwelling units. The property is located on the west side of State Road A1A South, south of Tropic Way and north of San Julian Boulevard on Anastasia Island. The Planning and Zoning Agency recommended approval of PUD 2014-18 by a unanimous vote of 5-0 at the March 19, 2015 meeting. The purpose of this ordinance is to provide a means by which property can be evaluated, decontaminated, and returned to use when found to be unsafe and unfit for use due to chemical contamination that may have resulted from illegal drug manufacturing, processing, refinement, or creation when hazardous chemicals were used in such process. This is the first reading of said ordinance. The proposed second reading and enactment of this ordinance is scheduled for May 17, 2015, in public hearing before the Board of County Commissioners.


