1. Public Hearing * MAJMOD 2019-11 SJSO Training Facility. Request for a Major Modification to the St. Johns County Sheriff's Office Training Facility Planned Unit Development (Ordinance 2015-7, as amended) to rezone adjoining land to accommodate reconfiguration of the site design and update the Master Development Plan. The property is located on the west side of Interstate 95, south of County Road 208, with access provided from Agricultural Center Drive. The Planning and Zoning Agency heard this item on February 20, 2020 and voted 6-0 to recommend approval of the modification.

2. Discussion Items - Vacation Rentals and Adjacent Property Owner notifications.

At the direction of the Board of County Commissioners, staff was asked to research and bring back two (2) proposals for discussion and address the regulation of Short Term Vacation Rentals. Additionally, during Commissioners Comments at a regularly scheduled public hearing, staff was asked to research Adjacent Property Owner notification distance requirements. This discussion item would assess if Saint Johns County should increase the radius from which neighboring properties are notified that may potentially be affected by a development application. Staff seeks direction from the Board on all items.

3. Public Hearing * COMPAMD 2019-07 St. Marks Campground (TRANSMITTAL). Transmittal hearing for COMPAMD 2019-07 St. Marks Campground to change the Future Land Use Map designation of approximately 74.14 acres of land from Rural/Silviculture (R/S) to Rural Commercial (RC). The subject property is located approximately 1 mile west of US Highway 1 on the south side of International Golf Parkway, and west of St. Marks Pond Boulevard. the Planning and Zoning Agency heard this item on February 6, 2020 and voted 7-0 in favor of recommending Transmittal.

4. Public Hearing * COMPAMD 2019-01 Oxford Estates East (TRANSMITTAL). Transmittal hearing for COMPAMD 2019-01 Oxford Estates East (Future Phase) to change the Future Land Use Map designation of approximately 32 acres from Rural/Silviculture (R/S) to Residential-B (RES-B) for the expansion of the Oxford Estates PUD. The subject property is located on the east side of Longleaf Pine Parkway and north of Oxbridge Way. Access to the proposed future phase would be through Old Hale Way. The Planning and Zoning Agency heard this item on February 6, 2020, and voted 5-2 in favor of recommending Transmittal. There was no public input.

5. Public Hearing * **REZ 2019-22 Boggs Storage Lot.** A request to rezone approximately 3.0 acres of land from Open Rural (OR) to Commercial Intensive (CI) to allow for high intensity uses including, but not limited to, RV/Boat Storage and Personal Property/Mini-Warehouse uses. This item was heard by the Planning and Zoning Agency (PZA) at their regularly scheduled Public Hearing on February 6, 2020 and was unanimously recommended for approval by a vote of 7-0.

Public Hearing * DEVAGRMOD 2019-01 Durbin Creek National Development 6. Agreement Modification (First Reading). This is the second amendment of the Durbin Creek National Development Agreement that was approved in 2015 and amended in 2016. The modification requests to revise the phasing schedule and corresponding transportation commitments to accommodate the proposed Durbin Park PUD located on the east side of SR 9B. The request also includes a land use exchange to convert 534,545 sq. ft. of office park space to 1,266 additional apartment units and 150 hospital beds with no increase in the project's external traffic. The proposed changes include revising the project development phasing to accelerate development entitlement; and revising the transportation commitments to combine Race Track Road widening into one phase from Bartram Park Blvd. to Bartram Springs Pkwy instead of two phases, and removing the requirement to 6-lane Race Track Rd at build out. Two public hearings are required to modify a Development Agreement. The second public hearing is scheduled before the BCC on May 19, 2020. There are two other companion applications, a Comprehensive Plan Amendment and a Planned Unit Development, that will be heard concurrently with this Development Agreement.

7. Report on state tobacco legislation and St. Johns County tobacco ordinances. At its February 4, 2020 meeting, the Board of County Commissioners heard a presentation from Tobacco Free St. Johns on the Summit Outcome Report from its program entitled "Turning the Tide - Solving the Youth E-Epidemic in Northeast Florida." A portion of the presentation discussed state and federal legislation addressing electronic nicotine-dispensing devices and the minimum age for the purchase of tobacco products. Following the presentation, the Board directed the Office of the County Attorney to bring back a report on the status of state tobacco legislation and options for updating the County's ordinances dealing with the sale and display of tobacco products.

8. Recreation Advisory Board's Recommendation in memory of Mr. Keith Martin. Field of Dreams Baseball is a member of the Creeks Athletic Association. It is a handicap accessible turf baseball and playground facility that offers Recreational Baseball and an ADA accessible playground for exceptional children. The Field of Dreams is located at 1401 Shetland Drive, St. Johns, FL 32259 near Aberdeen Park and was built using funds donated by the Field of Dreams Board and Creeks Athletic Association that were collected through fundraisers and contributions. Kim Kendall is requesting that the facility be named Keith Martin Field of Dreams in honor of his years of service with St. Johns Middles School Athletic Association and Creeks Athletic Association. Mr. Martin passed away in February of 2020. The Policy For The Naming Of All Public Facilities Item 2. requires that "Proposals to name facilities after persons are restricted to those persons who are deceased. A waiting period of no less that twelve (12) months from the death will be maintained." Item 4. states, "The process of naming of facilities will be through the appropriate advisory board, if applicable." At the March 3, 2020 Board of County Commissioners meeting the Board tasked the Recreation Advisory Board to evaluate this request at their March 12, 2020 board meeting and provide their recommendation.

Public Hearing * Resolution declaring certain St. Johns County Community Redevelopment Agency owned property as surplus; approving a transfer of property to the West Augustine Historical Community Development Corporation and authorizing the Board Chair to execute the County Deed on behalf of the St. Johns County Board of County Commissioners. The West Augustine Historical Community Development Corporation (WAHCDC) has expressed an interest in acquiring the subject parcels in an effort to facilitate a project that will address housing and economic development in the West Augustine Community. St. Johns County acquired the subject parcels (116800-0070 & 116800-000), in conjunction with approximately 280 other parcels in the West Augustine area, in 2002. In 2004, the subject parcels were transferred to the St. Johns County Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA). The assessed value of both lots is \$8,887. properties contain no structures and have no access to an improved right of way. The proposed transaction was advertised on February 7, 2020 and February 14, 2020 in accordance with Section 163,380, Florida Statute. Other departments within the County were solicited and were not found to have a use for the subject parcels. Staff is in support of this transfer. Per the attached deed, the property will be restricted for construction of affordable housing and economic development.


