2. Discussion of SB 1066. SB 1066 (Laws of Florida, CHAPTER 2020-58) amends Section 163.31801, F.S. and includes the provision: "Impact fee credits are assignable and transferable at any time after establishment from one development or parcel to any other that is within the same impact fee zone or impact fee district or that is within an adjoining impact fee zone or impact fee district within the same local government jurisdiction and receives benefits from the improvement or contribution that generated the credits." This provision became effective July 1, 2020.

3. *Public Hearing* * LDC Amendment - Article VI "Roadway Design". Amends Article VI, Section 6.04.07.F.1.e "Pavement Design" to allow the subgrade on local roadways with less than 2000 Annual Average Daily Trips (AADT) to be designed by a Registered Professional in accordance with Section 5.2.2. of the FDOT January 2020 published Flexible Pavement Design Manual.
